

Note:

Read and comply with Information on replacing shock absorbers.

Necessary preliminary tasks:

- Remove rear wheel
- E85: Remove mounting for convertible top compartment floor
- E86: Remove luggage compartment wheel arch trim



Warning!

Danger of injury!

Failure to comply with the following instructions may result in the vehicle slipping off the lifting platform and critically injuring other persons.


When supporting components, make sure that


- the vehicle can no longer be raised or lowered
- the vehicle does not lift off the locating plates on the lifting platform

Support trailing arm with a workshop jack (1). Release screw.

Installation:

Thrust washer (2) on rubber bearing must point to screw head. Tighten bolt in normal position. Tightening torque, 33 52 1AZ






Unscrew nuts.

Remove shock absorber with support bearing towards bottom.

Installation:

Replace sealing washer (between support bearing and body). Replace self-locking nuts.

Tightening torque 33 52 3AZ .



Replacement:

Remove support bearing.

Remove or detach plate (1), spacer, auxiliary damper (2) and protective tube (3) from shock absorber (4).

Installation:

Check auxiliary damper (2) and protective tube (3) for damage, replace if necessary.

After installation:

• Check that output shaft is correctly seated in rear differential.
